From this moment until the Full Moon, Moon is growing. And so the following 2 weeks is the time to nurture your intention (water your seed).


Aries is a fire sign and as all fire signs it supports movement, accomplishing goals and moving forward.

The Full Spectrum fo Female Sexuality

- Women can experience 6 types of vaginal orgasms: G-spot, A-spot, K-spot, P-spot, cervix, entry to vagina.
- We can also have anal orgasms.
- And clitoral orgasms.
- And even nipple orgasm.
- And even throat orgasm!
- Women can experience orgasms without even being touched.
- A female body is capable of experiencing multiple, full-body orgasms.
- Women can squirt. And the liquid produced in Tantric traditions is considered sacred (amrita).







Yoni Puja

- Yoni = womb, vagina; origin, abode, or source; goddess Shakti
- Puja = worship, celebration
- Yoni Puja = celebration to honor the yoni, either of the universe, of the goddess or of a woman





Yoni Puja

- You will need: flowers, honey, milk, mirror, towel
- Always prepare the space & yourself: clean the room, take a shower, smudge the space and yourself
- Step 1: Start by connecting to your hip area through movement and dance
- Step 2: Sit in front of the mirror without underwear (you can sit on a towel)
- Step 3: Yoni Gazing (gaze at the reflection of your yoni)
- Step 4: Offering (offer flower petals, milk and honey to your yoni by pouring them over her)
- Step 5: Bow down to your yoni in awe and gratitude







Planet Venus

- Venus is a powerful **archetype** of women, femininity, and female gifts.
- In **astrology**, Venus is the planet associated with love, romance, relationships, sex and pleasure.
- In ancient mythology, Venus was the goddess of love and pleasure. She is Aphrodite, the goddess of love and beauty; and Lakshmi, the goddess of love and abundance.

In astrology each day corresponds to a specific Planet:

- Monday Moon
- Tuesday Mars
- Wednesday Mercury
- Thursday Jupiter
- Friday Venus
- Saturday Saturn
- Sunday Sun
